## ΑΠΟΦΑΣΕΙΣ

Αριθ. Φ.0544/4/ΑΣ 66/Μ. 4663

«Έγκριση του Πρωτοκόλλου της 8ης Συνόδου της Μικτής Ελληνο-τουρκικής Επιτροπής Οδικών Μεταφορών Επιβατών και Εμπορευμάτων που υπογράφηκε στην Άγκυρα στις 1.11.1996».

Έχοντες υπόψη: 1) τις διατάξεις του άρθρου 26 παρ. 2 της Συμφωνίας Οδικών Μεταφορών Ελλάδας - Τουρκίας που υπογράφηκε στην Άγκυρα στις 4.4.1970 και κυρώθηκε με το υπ' αριθ. 877/1971 Νομοθετικό Διάταγμα (ΦΕΚ Α' 117/1971), με τις οποίες συνιστάται Μικτή Ελληνοτουρκική Επιτροπή Οδικών Μεταφορών.

2) το περιεχόμενο του υπό έγκριση Πρωτοκόλλου, αποφασίζουμε:

Εγκρίνουμε ως έχει και στο σύνολό του το Πρωτόκολλο της 8ης Συνόδου της Μικτής Ελληνο-τουρκικής Επιτροπής Οδικών Μεταφορών Επιβατών και Εμπορευμάτων που υπογράφηκε στην Άγκυρα στις 1.11.1996 το κείμενο του οποίου σε πρωτότυπο στην Αγγλική γλώσσα και σε μετάφραση στην Ελληνική έχει ως εξής:

## PROTOCOL

OF THE EIGHTH SESSION OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE  
ON ROAD TRANSPORT OF PASSENGER AND GOODS  
BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE HELLENIC RE-  
PUBLIC AND THE REPUBLIC OF TURKEY

The Joint Committee meeting of the road transport between Turkey - Greece was held on 31 October and 1 November 1996 in Ankara.

The Turkish Delegation was headed by Mr. Yasar TUNCER, the Deputy Undersecretary of state for the Min-

istry of Transport, and the Greek Delegation was headed by Mr. Christos POLYDOROPOULOS, Director General of the Ministry of Transport of Greece.

List of the delegations are annexed. Negotiations were made on the basis of the following agenda:

1. Development of the land transport between two countries and exchange of the statistical data.

2. Transport of Passengers,

3. Transport of Goods,

4. Other Subjects

Both Sides expressed their views on the ways and methods of further development of the road transport and agreed on the following subjects:

1. The Sides exchanged information on bilateral and transit transport between and through their countries to develop the cooperation on this field.

The Two Sides expressed that the road transport between the two countries is made in accordance with the existing Agreement.

2. Both Sides expressed their pleasure about the existing regular bus line between Turkey and Greece.

Both Sides agreed that permits issued for the existing regular passenger transport lines between the two countries will henceforth be valid for two years.

As far as the regular line service between Istanbul-Athens is concerned, both sides agreed that the number of journeys operated per day should be increased to two as of 1997, on the condition that an agreement is reached by the companies operating this line.

Furthermore, the two sides agreed to encourage the establishment of a new regular line between Bursa-Xanthi and vice-versa on the condition that the passenger transport companies concerned mutually agree to operate this line.

The Sides exchanged information on passenger transports between the two countries and stated that they will take the necessary measures to continue them in accordance with the bilateral and multilateral agreement.

3. The two delegations exchanged information of bilateral and transit transport of goods between and through their countries and agreed to develop their cooperation in this field.

The two sides agreed on the quota of 9.500 permits for 1997 valid both for transit and bilateral transport.
